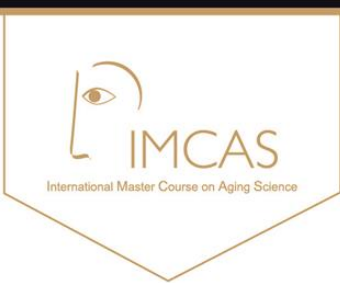

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING CME CREDITS:

EUROPE

IMCAS is accredited by the European Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (EACCME) to provide CME credit activities for physicians. The EACCME is an institution of the European Union of Medical Specialists (UEMS).
